


Lab 1 - Environment Setup


Environment




As what is shown in above diagram, I deployed NetBeans 7.4 and Tomcat 7.0.41 to my system.

Instructions on how to deploy it to Tomcat


1. In NetBeans, File->New Project. Select HTML5-> HTML5 Application as following screenshot



2. Following the wizard to create a new project. In the wizard select No Site Template.
 3. Copying my index.html and data folder to the Site Root folder you just created in step 2.
- Finally, you will see following directory structure in the Projects area of Netbeans:



4. Click Run Project button or F6 in NetBeans to launch the project.
5. The web page will be displayed in the Chrome as following screenshot:
